1. Festival Events

- 1.1 Open A (Will be participate higher than elo 2001 and Fide title Players)
- 1.2 Open B (Will be participate low than elo 2000)
- 1.3 Boys under age 8 (Date of birth 2005 and after)
- 1.4 Girls under age 8 (Date of birth 2005 and after)
- 1.5 Boys under age 10 (Date of birth 2003 and after)
- 1.6 Girls under age 10 (Date of birth 2003 and after)
- 1.7 Boys under age 12 (Date of birth 2001 and after)
- 1.8 Girls under age 12 (Date of birth 2001 and after)

2. System and Rate of Play

2.1 Time Control:

- **Open A** - The playing time will be 90 minutes for 40 moves plus 30 minutes for the rest of the game with an increment of 30 seconds per move, starting from move one.

- **Open B, U8, U10, U12 B&G** - 90 minutes + 30 seconds per move.

2.2 Festival tournaments will be 9 rounds, played in the Swiss system.

2.3 Pairings will be carried out with the computer program – **Swiss Manager**.

4. Tie-Break System and Trophies

4.1 In case of equal points the order of players will be determined by the following tie-break procedures:

1. Median Buchholz -1, the highest number wins;
2. Buchholz, the highest number wins;
3. The greater number of victories;
4. Progressive score;

4.2 Winners will be awarded Nana Aleksandria's cups, respective diplomas and money prizes.

4.3 In age tournaments will be detected and awarded Nana Aleksandria's Cups and respective Diplomas for the Best results U7, U9 and U11 years girls and boys.

5. Prize fund – 32 000 GEL (19 300 USD)

Prizes will be taxed to Georgian Legislation.
